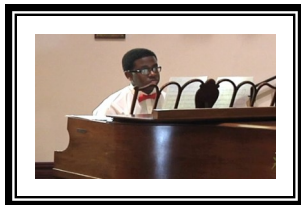

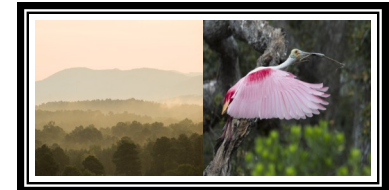

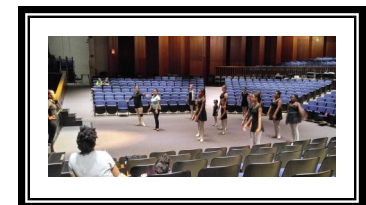

Goals

In the spirit of the Alabama Shakespeare Festival that originated in Anniston, the **Anniston City Board of Education** in partnership with **Cheaha Creative Arts, Inc.** approved for the property use of the National Register Thomas E. Kilby House and the Anniston Performing Arts Center to house **CCA Kilby House** and the **PACP After-School Fine Arts Educational Programs**. This initiative shall be a **21st Century Program** for every child who dreams to perform on stage before an audience. For every child who wants to learn, create, share talents and friendships. **CCA After-School Fine Arts Program** shall be the catalyst that makes dream opportunities become a reality.

The **CCA After-School Fine Arts Program** is open to all children who attend public, private, home school programs in Anniston and Calhoun County providing to the students a multidisciplinary fine arts genre performance program designed to educate, inform and inspire in artistic training.

The **CCA After-School Fine Arts Program** Instructors have the sole discretion to determine the students age or grade level for participation in their specific arts genre program.

The **CCA After-School Fine Arts Program** shall create positive relationships between students who participate in the multidisciplinary fine arts genre performance program within the Anniston and Calhoun County Communities.

The **CCA After-School Fine Arts Program** students who participate shall develop problem-solving skills and tools which enhance verbal and nonverbal communication.

The **CCA After-School Fine Arts Program** provides opportunities to students who attend the choice to select several multidisciplinary arts genres that excels personal development and enhances quality of life.

The **CCA After-School Fine Arts Program** is beneficial to all students who participate; studies have shown the arts give children the opportunity for a unique self-expression, group participation and self-directed learning.

The **CCA After-School Fine Arts Program** encourages each individual student to work in a creative, cooperative and collaborative manner while promoting independent thinking.

The **CCA After-School Fine Arts Program** high standards in teaching and learning requirements shall produce a participative creative environment where students can learn, based on proof by increased improvement in their academic performance.

Plan

The planned **mission** of the **CCA After-School Fine Arts Program** is to prepare school aged children in Calhoun County, who have an interest in the arts a way to pursue their unique skills and talents through a multidisciplinary fine arts genre performance program with high standards that combines critical thinking and a whole-person developmental approach to learning.

CCA After-School Fine Arts Program shall be a high quality educational program for students in Calhoun County, developing the whole person through a multidisciplinary fine arts genre performance program.

CCA After-School Fine Arts Program aims to develop creative independent responsible student's artistically and socially building unity within Anniston and the Calhoun County communities.

CCA After-School Fine Arts Program is a unique one of a kind low cost ongoing multidisciplinary fine arts performance program starting in August through May with a two week performing arts camp during June, designed to educate, inform and inspire children who attend public, private, home school programs in Anniston and Calhoun County housed at the Anniston Performing Arts Center. Instructors are a cultural diverse group of professionally skilled community artists.

CCA After-School Fine Arts Program classes shall be given two weeks per month with designated days scheduled for each arts genre.

CCA After-School Fine Arts Program students participating must have an application, liability release and photo release form on file to participate in the program.
